Preschool 3 Classroom Curriculum

September - Welcome to School!

- All About School- Children will become acquainted with their classroom surroundings, procedures and behavior expectations. Classroom and playground safety will be discussed and practiced.
- My Family, Friends & Community- Children will share their likes and dislikes, talk about their families, neighbors/neighborhoods, talk about people who work in the community, and understand how to be safe.
- The letters- A, B, C; numbers- 1, 2; colors- red, blue; shape- circle.

October – My Five Senses

- Fall and Our Senses- Children will explore the world using their senses. They will discuss the five senses and students will discover the smells, tastes, sights, sounds, and feelings of fall through investigating nature.
- The letters- D, E, F, G; numbers- 3, 4; colors- yellow, orange; shapes- triangle, square.

November - Seasons All Around

- Weather Children talk about different kinds of weather and how it affects the environment. Students will also discover how and why the seasons change.
- The letter- H; review letters A G; review numbers- 1
- 4; review colors- red, blue, yellow, orange; shapes-circle, triangle and square.

<u>December – Holidays</u>

- Holiday Happenings- Christmas Celebrations in different cultures through songs and crafts.
- The letters- I, J, K; numbers- 5, 6; color- green; shape-rectangle.

<u>January – Animals Everywhere</u>

- Animals We Know children will be engaged in activities that center on animals, their behavior, and their habitats. Students will share what they like about animals and discuss familiar animals
- The letters- L, M, N, O; numbers- 7, 8; colors- purple, black; shape -star.

February – Construction Zone

- Build Together Children will be engaged in activities that encourage motor skills, creativity, and teamwork.
- Children will explore making and building things;
 working together to solve a problem and accomplish a big job.
- The letters- P, Q; review letters- I − O; numbers- 5 − 8;
 color- brown; shape heart.

March – In The City, In The Country

- Country vs. City Children will engage in activities that encourage investigation into country life and city life. They will learn about life and animals on a farm; find out about the bustle of city life; and discover how products get to market.
- The letters- R, S, T; numbers- 9, 10; review colorsgreen, purple, black; review shapes- heart, star and rectangle.

April - Let's Move

- Moving & Grooving students will be engaged in activities that encourage and develop motor skills, creativity, and teamwork. Children investigate ways to move their bodies; describe their plans and movements; move and play together.
- The letters- U, V, W, X; review numbers- 1 − 10; review all colors; review all shapes.

May – Growing & Changing

- Growth in Spring children will engage in activities that reveal how time changes the world around them—and how it changes them, too! Students will observe how they have changed over time; learn that nature changes, too; and investigate signs of growth in nature.
- Ready for PreK- students are engaged in activities that revisit and review all of the things they have learned!
- The letters- Y, Z; review letters P X; review counting 1 – 10 forwards and backwards.
