^{*}Notes: (1) Please make sure that you read this schedule as we adhere to this timeline daily in order to ensure that we run a smooth and orderly center. (2) We will have outdoor play unless conditions are extreme, please make sure you dress your child appropriately with clothing that they can easily put on and take off without assistance. (3) Free play may encompass music, movement, dramatic play, manipulatives (i.e. puzzles), coloring, blocks, etc.

School Supplies

In order to ensure that all children have the same quality and quantity of supplies for our activities, we require a center supply fee (please make sure this has been submitted one week prior to your child's first day of school). This eliminates the need for supply shopping but we encourage you to have them at home as your child will have homework and will need pencils, child safety scissors, glue/glue sticks, and markers/crayons/colored pencils at home to complete their assignments.

The only items your child will need to bring to school daily - aside from periodic specific requests made by the teacher for special classroom projects - are:

- 1. A backpack to store completed daily crafts and a change of clothes (don't forget this will need to be changed out seasonally).
- 2. Your child has been issued a knapsack labeled with your child's name this will need to contain a **small** blanket, a **small** pillow and one **small** nap toy (optional). All items must be labeled and fit inside this bag no exceptions. This knapsack will stay at the center for the week and be taken home on your child's last day of scheduled child care for washing.
- 3. Homework folder: Please bring **daily** as correspondence and occasional activities will be sent home via this folder.

Important note: In order to keep your child's items safe, please do not send any toys from home (other than for naptime or designated Show & Tell day) as there is a risk for loss or breakage; please leave these items in the car before coming into the center.

Conference Time

November is the time of year when we meet with parents to discuss their child's successes and challenges in our program. Teachers will be using evaluations of student academic, social, emotional, behavioral, physical, etc. progress to give parents an idea of how well their child is doing in each area of development. Please watch for a conference schedule sheet on your student's classroom bulletin board so that you can sign up for a time to meet with your child's teacher. If you are unable to meet in person, a phone conference is available but you must still reserve an appointment time to do so.
